

Dear Patient:

Our primary care network at Catawba Valley Medical Group has begun to operate as a Medical Home. This is a new concept of healthcare that places an emphasis on the relationship between you and your healthcare team ... with **YOU** being the most important team member!

What is a Medical Home?

A Medical Home is a new concept in healthcare that focuses on a team approach to provide comprehensive, high quality health- care that is cost-effective. We want to nurture a continuous relationship with our patients and partner with you so you can be as healthy as possible.

What is Different?

Partnership:

We ask that you take an active role in your health and partner with us. You can do this by discussing with us problems you may be experiencing with your medications {for example: if you don't take them; if they are too expensive; if they make you sick}. Ask questions and share your feelings.

Improved Access:

We have worked hard to modify our schedules to provide you with same day availability {in most instances.} It is important that you not only come at your scheduled time, but also notify us immediately if you need to reschedule the appointment.

There is an on-call physician every evening during the week {Monday through Thursday} from 5:00 p.m. until 8:00 a.m. and on the weekends beginning at 5:00 p.m. on Fridays through 8:00 a.m. on Mondays. The on-call physician can be reached by calling 828-324-0258.

Catawba Valley Medical Group has extended hours at two convenient locations:

- Catawba Valley Family Medicine- Claremont is open from 5:30 p.m until 8:30 p.m on Tuesdays and Thursdays Only. No appointment is
 necessary. Anyone in need of non-life-threatening medical care is welcome to come to the office to be seen by a provider as a walk in or
 as a scheduled patient by calling 828-732.5050.
- 2. Catawba Valley Family Medicine- Maiden is open on Saturdays from 9:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. No appointment is necessary. Anyone in need of non-life-threatening medical care is welcome to come to the office to be seen by a provider as a walk in or as a scheduled patient by calling 828-732-5000.

Our goal is to provide care for non-emergency or non-life-threatening conditions. If you are experiencing an emergency or life-threatening condition you should be treated in the Emergency Department.

Preventive and Chronic Care:

Additional staff have been hired to discuss preventive care with patients. You may receive a phone call or a letter informing you that you are due for certain chronic care or preventive services. Our goal is to help prevent you from developing serious medical problems in the future. This may include a screening colonoscopy, mammogram or other preventive services. Many of these preventive services are provided free of charge through various insurance companies. Please let your Medical Home know if you choose not to receive these preventive reminders.

If you have a chronic condition such as diabetes or high blood pressure we will try to schedule your routine check-ups before you leave the office. So that we can appropriately treat your condition, you may receive a phone call to schedule your check-up sooner if a lab result indicates that your condition may be worsening.

Our goal is to be proactive with your healthcare to prevent conditions from occurring or worsening rather than being reactive when a condition does occur. By closing the loop in your healthcare with preventive and chronic care we will work together to promote a healthier you and ultimately decrease overall healthcare costs.

What is a Medical Home?

A medical home is a model of care consisting of a team approach to provide comprehensive health care in a high-quality yet cost-effective manner. This type of care focuses on a continuous relationship with a personal health care provider relationship with a personal health care provider you select. Your chosen provider will take responsibility for coordinating your care through all stages of your life. This unique partnership between you and your health care provider means you always have active involvement in your own health care plans.

Partner for your Health:

- Let's work together to develop a plan of care
- Commit to and follow your plan of care
- Let us know if you are unable to take your medicine or follow through with your plan of care
- Inform us of any illnesses, hospitalizations, new medications and/or other health-related matters since your last visit
- Tell us about your needs and concerns
- Ask a member of your health care team for help if you don't fully understand something
- Prepare an Advance Care Directive and be certain we have it on file
- Understand that your lifestyle choices affect your personal health
- Give us feedback so we can improve our services

As your personal healthcare provider, my responsibilities are:

To explain your conditions, list treatment options, and work with you to help plan your care. I will provide your test results in an easy-to-understand way, listen to your feelings and questions when making decisions to guide your care. Discussions about your treatment and records will remain confidential. Our office will provide you with a same day appointment whenever possible. Your healthcare team will give you clear directions about medicine and other treatments that will help you, and will also provide you with instructions on how to meet your health care needs when our office is closed, offering you 24-hour access to clinical advice. Your provider will refer you to a trusted specialist, if needed. I will end each visit by making sure you have a clear understanding of the instructions about expectations, treatment goals and future plans for your care.

Before you visit the Emergency Department please call 828-324-0258. An on-call physician is available after hours from 5:00pm- 8:00am to offer clinical advice. Our goal is to return your call within 30 minutes.

Choose the right health care setting when you need it.

The quality and cost of medical care can vary widely, depending on where you go for treatment and services. If possible, go to your Catawba Valley Medical Group (CVMG) primary care/family doctor for medical care. Your CVMG team knows you best and can quickly access your medical records.

There are times when you might need treatment and services at facility other than your doctor's office. The following are examples of different health care providers and the services they generally provide:

Visit your doctor's office when you need routine care or treatment for current, non-life threatening health issues. Your doctor knows you and your health history and can provide: Routine checkups Annual wellness visits Preventive care Immunizations Treatment of minor injuries, sprains and strains Treatment of common infections Care to manage your general health* Same day appointments Saturday clinic (walk-in and scheduled appointments) A CVMG physician on-call available to speak with you by phone when the clinic is closed	Urgent care centers offer treatment for urgent, but non-life threatening injuries or illnesses. They are available on a walk-in basis and offer extended weekday hours and weekend hours to provide: Treatment of minor infections Treatment of minor injuries, sprains, strains, minor broken bones Small cuts that may need a few stitches*	The Emergency Room (ER) is for the treatment of life-threatening conditions that require immediate medical attention such as: Chest pain Difficulty breathing Signs/symptoms of stroke Sudden change in vision Severe injury Heavy bleeding Large open wounds Major broken bones* Catawba Valley Medical Center and CVMG are part of the same health care system, which allows the hospital and your doctors to care for you in the hospital and at home.
